Villarica Merlot, Chile 2008 £14.50, glass £4.70 250ml

Very smooth merlot from Maule valley, with good depth and clean finish.

Simply Shiraz, France 2008 £15.95

Klippenkop Pinotage South Africa 2008 £17.50

**South Africa's own wine – a cross of Pinot Noir and Cinsault. Good fruit flavours
and perfect with rich food**

Rioja Bodegas Artesa Spain 2006 £19.50

**A forward and attractive modern style of Crianza with fresh plum and red berry
aromas complemented by spicy vanilla oak. An attractively long finish, with
gentle spicy balsamic notes from 12 months barrel ageing.**

A fruity wine with aromas of plums and vanilla with a long, rich finish

Montepulciano barricato, Italy 2006 £19.95
